#### Detailed Information:

- The Corn Hill Arts Festival annual **estimated economic impact is over \$500,000**. We estimate that approximately 125,000 visitors attend the Festival annually. They come from the City of Rochester and surrounding counties. Artists, exhibitors, sponsors and food vendors come from across the U.S. to participate. These people utilize hotels, restaurants, gas and other retail establishments. We use multiple vendors to provide needed services and equipment.
- Over **365 original artists and craftspeople**, selected by a jury, display and sell their work. **Cash prizes of \$8,000** are awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners in 8 categories; **Glass/Sculpture, Jewelry, Mixed Media, Painting/Drawing/Graphics, Photography, Pottery/Ceramics, Weaving/Leather/Textile Design, and Woodworking**
- **ESL Federal Credit Union is the presenting sponsor of the 2019 Corn Hill Arts Festival.** ESL will offer a hospitality tent located in Lunsford Circle to the public. In addition, the ESL “Kindness Crew” will be on the streets with some special items for visitors.
- **City Newspaper** produces the “Official Festival Guide” and is available in all City Newspapers, at the Festival and online for easy access to information.

- **The Michelob Ultra Beer Garden** is located at two locations in 2019, Lunsford Circle and at The WellNow Urgent Care Main Stage at the Food Court. - **The Wine Travel Card** will be presenting the Wine/Cider & Spirit Garden in Lunsford Circle. Multiple wineries, cideries, and distilleries will be offering tastings and products for sale at the Garden.
- **Food Court and Food Trucks** will be offering a variety of your favorite Festival foods in addition to international offerings. Beer & wine will be available for purchase in the Food Court. The Food Court is located off Adams and off Edinburgh St and is adjacent to the Main Stage.
- **7<sup>th</sup> Annual Fairy Houses Tour** - Over 40 original Fairy Houses will be exhibited at the Community area off Adams St. for viewing. A Fairy will be on hand to interact with visitors. Prizes will be awarded for “Most Whimsical and Best Use of Natural Materials” in three categories. Visitors will vote for their favorite in our “People’s Choice Award” contest. And new this year, there will be one Fairy House available for a silent auction with all proceeds benefiting Gilda’s Club Rochester!
