Mission of the Organization: The objectives of Corn Hill Neighbors Association are:

Neighborhood Support Programs:

- **Arts Festival** - annual juried art show of fine arts and crafts.

- **Public Works** - maintaining communications with City of Rochester & County of Monroe officials relating to, but not limited to, street and sidewalk maintenance and cleaning, snow removal and the maintenance of public areas.
- **Development and Community Relations** - responsible for communicating between the development authorities of the City of Rochester and the Corn Hill Neighborhood Association, including, but not limited to, development plans and zoning matters, and permit parking. It shall also promote the neighborhood and be responsible for communications between the Association and other neighborhood organizations. We are also working with the City of Rochester on projects designed to bring life back to Downtown & the Genesee Riverfront area.
- **Philanthropy** - overseeing the distribution of monies to charitable and arts organizations.
- **Security/PAC-TAC** - responsible for communicating with police and fire services, including the administration of the PAC-TAC program.
- **Social** - responsible for planning, arranging and communicating with all neighborhoods concerning social functions.
- **Revolving Funds** - to provide low interest loans to residents of Corn Hill for property improvements.
- **Corn Hill Gazette:** providing an official means of communicating news and information consistent with the objectives of the Association to the members of the Association.
